SCIENTISTS WHO BELIEVED THE BIBLE

Sir Ambrose Fleming (1849-1945) was an electrical engineer and physicist who has been called *'the pioneer of electronics'*. His most famous invention was the thermionic valve – used in radios, etc before transistors were invented. He also established *the right-hand rule*, still used in physics today. In 1885, he became the first professor of electrical engineering at University College, London. Then in 1892, he was elected a Fellow of the Royal Society (of scientists).



This highly decorated scientist (receiving a medal from the Royal Society in 1910; the Albert Medal from The Royal Society of Arts in 1921; the Faraday Medal by the Institution of Electrical Engineers in 1928; and was knighted in recognition of his scientific achievements 1929) was a strong, Bible believing Christian. In fact, he wrote these words on the matter: "There is abundant evidence that the Bible, though written by men, is not the product of the human mind. By countless multitudes it has always been revered as a communication to us from the Creator of the Universe."
